Glossary of Terms -- Judaism.

- 1. **Adonai** -- Hebrew for Lord. A title.
- 2. Bar Mitzvah -- Ritual for young men and women. Rite of passage.
- 3. **Elohim** -- Literally gods. A name applied to God in Hebrew Bible.
- 4. **Germara** -- Commentary on the Mishnah.
- 5. **Kosher** -- Literally "fit" or "proper". Ritual cleaning for food.
- 6. **Mishnah** -- Collection of oral laws.
- 7. **Purim** -- Jewish holiday which celebrates liberation from the Persians.
- 8. **Shema** -- Deut. 6:4. It is the closest to a creed in Judaism. God is one.
- 9. Synagogue -- Literally assembly. A meeting of the Jews that began in the Diaspora.
- 10. **Talmud** -- Collection of the Mishnah and Germara.
- 11. **Torah** -- The law. It refers to the first five books of the Bible.
- 12. **Yom Kippur** -- Day of Atonment.
- 13. **Zionism** -- Founded in late nineteenth century in order to find a natural homeland for the Jews.
