 - 2. Limited to the Ten Commandments
 - a. Exodus 20:15

- 3. We work so that we may give instead of self-aggrandizement or personal gain. Quite a contrast from the world.

 - 1. Put off unwholesome talk.
 - 2. James' remarks James 3:5-6
 - 3. The grief of the Holy Spirit. Do not make him out to be a liar.

 - 1. Bitterness
 - 2. Wrath
 - 3. Anger
 - 4. Clamor
 - 5. Slander
 - 6. Malice

 - C. Be content with what you have for then you will not be tempted to steal.
 - D. Speak graciously to one another.
