

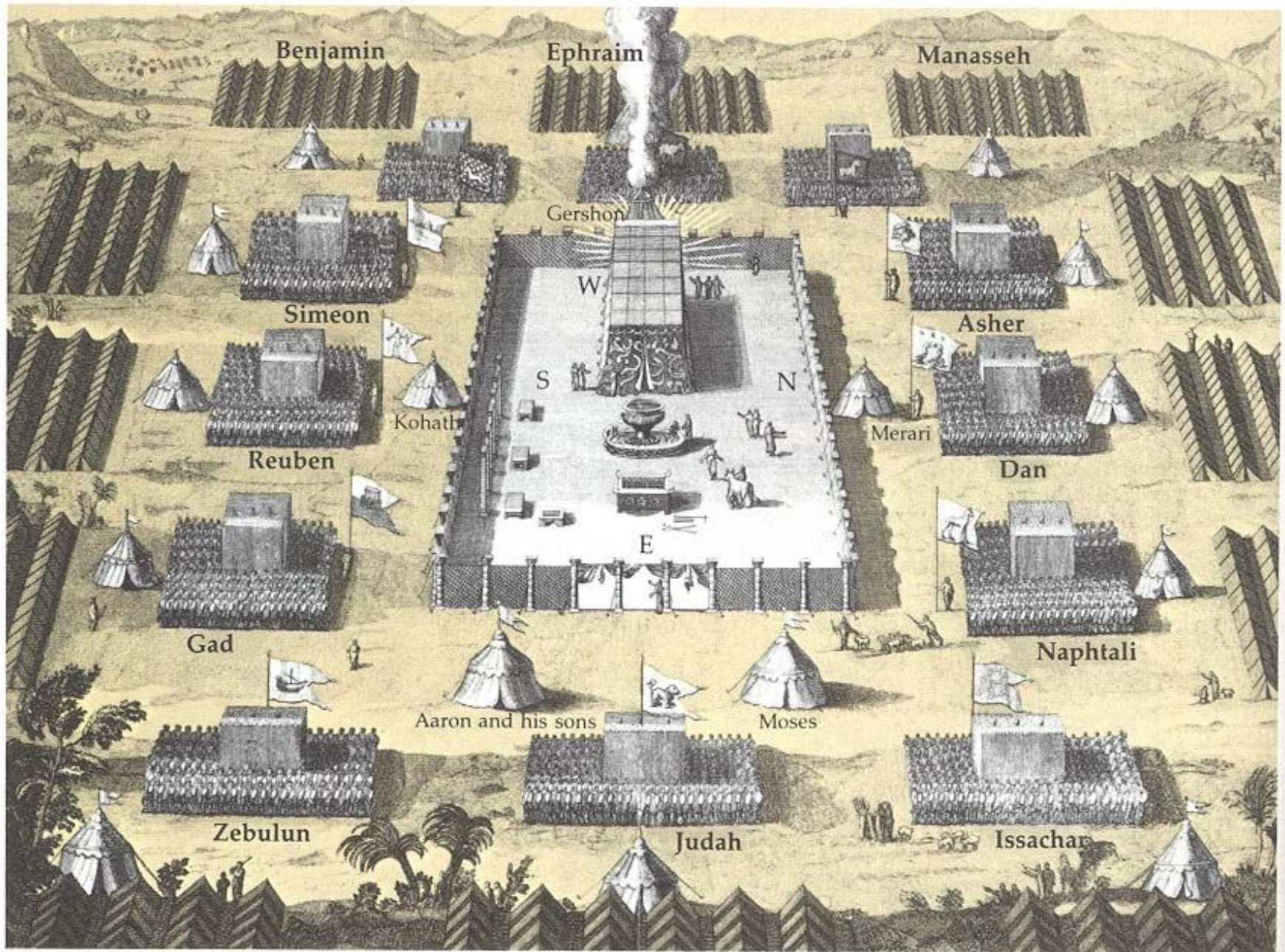
# Exodus – The Revealing of God’s Glory and His Design for the Chosen

#100 – A Closer Look at the Front  
Yard

Exodus 38:1-8



"They shall encamp facing the tent of meeting . . ."



## **Exodus 38:1-7**

“<sup>1</sup> Then he made the altar of burnt offering of acacia wood, five cubits long, and five cubits wide, square, and three cubits high. <sup>2</sup> He made its horns on its four corners, its horns being of one piece with it, and he overlaid it with bronze. <sup>3</sup> He made all the utensils of the altar, the pails and the shovels and the basins, the flesh hooks and the firepans; he made all its utensils of bronze. <sup>4</sup> He made for the altar a grating of bronze network beneath, under its ledge, reaching halfway up. <sup>5</sup> He cast four rings on the four ends of the bronze grating as holders for the poles. <sup>6</sup> He made the poles of acacia wood and overlaid them with bronze. <sup>7</sup> He inserted the poles into the rings on the sides of the altar, with which to carry it. He made it hollow with planks.”



## **Leviticus 6:12-13**

“<sup>12</sup> The fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it. It shall not go out, but the priest shall burn wood on it every morning; and he shall lay out the burnt offering on it, and offer up in smoke the fat portions of the peace offerings on it. <sup>13</sup> Fire shall be kept burning continually on the altar; it is not to go out.”

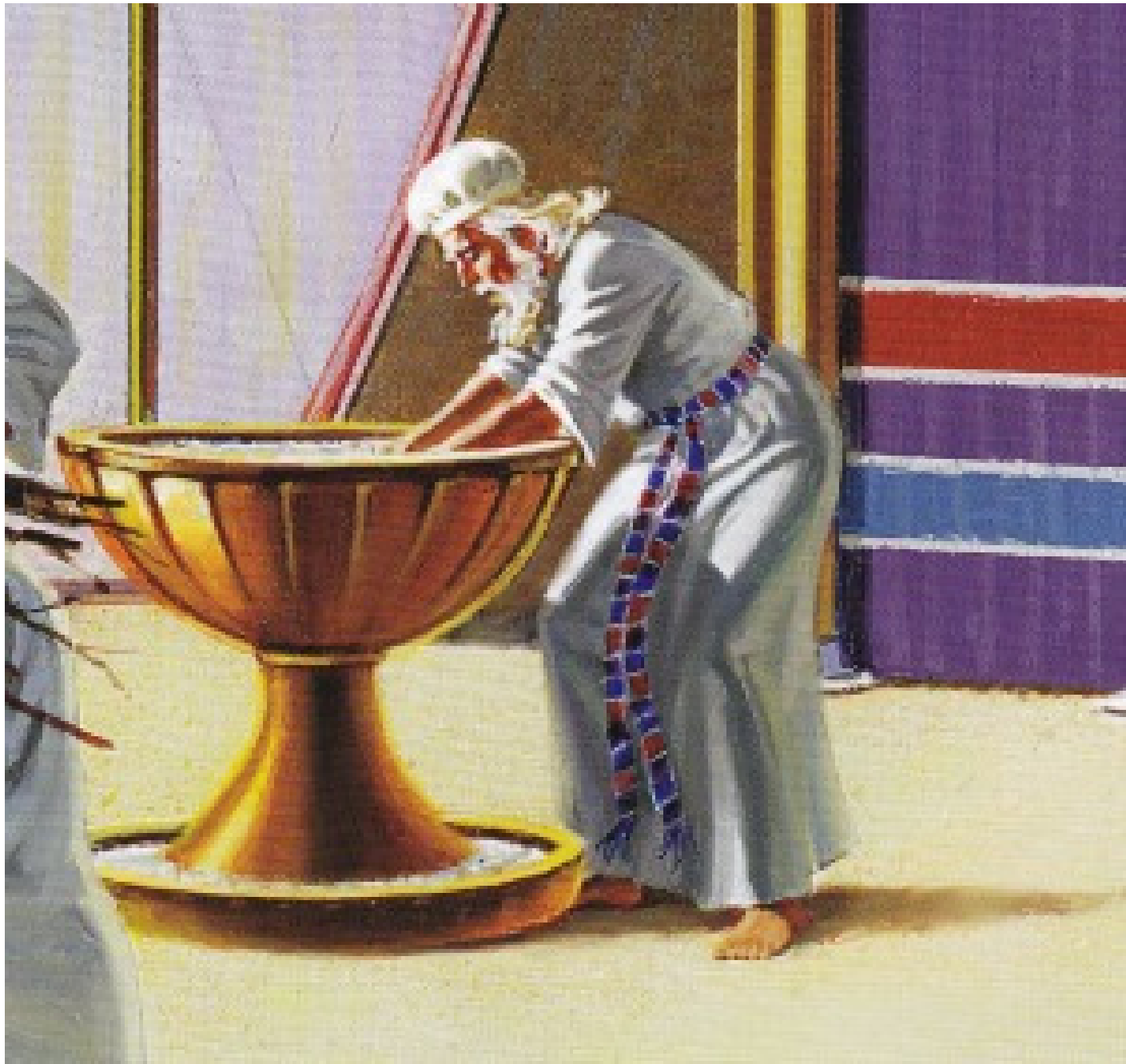
## I Corinthians 15:45-49

## **Exodus 38:8**

“<sup>8</sup> Moreover, he made the laver of bronze with its base of bronze, from the mirrors of the serving women who served at the doorway of the tent of meeting.”





## **Exodus 30:20-21a**

“<sup>20</sup> When they enter the tent of meeting, they shall wash with water, so that they will not die; or when they approach the altar to minister, by offering up in smoke a fire sacrifice to the Lord. <sup>21</sup> So they shall wash their hands and their feet, so that they will not die....”

## **Ephesians 5:26**

“<sup>26</sup> ...so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word.”

## **Titus 3:5**

“<sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.”
