Lesson #10

"The Seventh Commandment – No Adultery Equals Sexual Purity" – Part I

Exodus 20:14

"It is a thievish sin. It is the highest sort of theft. The adulterer steals from his neighbor that which is more than his goods and estate; he steals away his wife from him, who is flesh of his flesh."

# Galatians 4:7-9

"7 Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God. 8 However at that time, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those which by nature are no gods. 9 But now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God, how is it that you turn back again to the weak and worthless elemental things, to which you desire to be enslaved all over again?"

#### Genesis 24:65-67

"65 And she said to the servant, 'Who is that man walking in the field to meet us?' And the servant said, 'He is my master.' Then she took her veil and covered herself. 66 And the servant told Isaac all the things that he had done. <sup>67</sup> Then Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and he took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her; thus Isaac was comforted after his mother's death."

# Fornication is any sexual contact outside the bounds of marriage.

- 1. Prostitution
- 2. Homosexuality
- 3. Sexual violence, i.e. rape
- 4. Pedophilia
- 5. Incest

# I Corinthians 6:12

"All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything."

Standards for morality must be determined by the Scripture and not culture.

Adultery, like murder, is a more serious sin because it affords no restitution process.

Anytime a sex act occurs or is meditated upon outside of marriage - is in fact sin.

Louis Smedes notes in Mere Morality, p.157:

"The concern of the Seventh commandment is not merely with sex; its real business is with marriage and its wholeness. The commandment is about sex only insofar as sleeping with someone other than one's marriage partner is the most blatant and exciting way to commit adultery."
