"Final Thoughts – The Most Important Point: It's All About God's G\_\_\_\_" -- Exodus 40:1-38

## I. Introduction.

- A. Can you remember how far we have come in this book?
  - 1. Brutal slavery to freedom to serve God.
  - 2. God's glory is central to everything in this book. It's all about Him.
- B. Before the exposition one more thought-provoking aspect to Moses' intent in writing the book. 8 significant connections between Noah and Moses:
  - 1. Violence, Gen. 6:13; Ex. 1-2
  - 2. Ark (TEVAH) Gen. 6-9; Ex. 2:3,5
  - 3. Covenants Gen. 6:18; 9:11-17; Ex. 19-24
  - 4. Water Judgment Gen. 6-9; Ex. 13-15
  - 5. Wind Gen. 8:1; Ex. 14:21
  - 6. Animals Gen. 6:19; Ex. 1-40
  - 7. Divine Remembrance Gen. 8:1; Ex. 6:5

  - A. Exodus 40:1-32
    - 1. The final instructions on how and where to put things in the tabernacle.
      - a. God took pleasure in creating and arranging His earthly home.
  - B. Exodus 40:34-38
    - 1. They are waiting for God's glory to arrive.
      - a. Ex. 13:21-22; 14:19-20; 16:10; 24:15-17; 33:21-23; 34:5

- 4. Verse 35 The moment arrives.
  - a. Even the mediator could not get in!!
  - b. The delay highlights the frequent point of the necessity of an atonement.

  - a. Transcendence and Immanence.
  - b. They were not rescued to simply flounder in the wilderness.
  - c. Exodus' climatic story of God's glory descending is the beginning snowflakes signaling a colossal snowfall to come <u>Jesus</u>.
