## Exodus – The Revealing of God's Glory and His Design for the Chosen

"An Early Word on Resting" – Exodus 16:21-36

- I. Introduction.
  - A. Repetition for the memory is always a good thing.
    - 1. Pastor Don's experience.
    - 2. All of the Bible is important, but some things are said repeatedly.
  - B. Today's text highlights an often repeated command about rest.
    - 1. North Americans are always in search of rest.
  - C. Reading of the text Exodus 16:21-36
    - 1. Clement of Rome
- II. Exposition.
  - A. Verse 21.
    - 1. "Gathered it morning by morning" no hoarding.
  - B. Verse 22.
    - 1. Double portion for Sunday observance Exodus 16:5
  - C. Verses 23-24.
    - 1. A "holy" day.
  - D. Verses 25-27.
    - 1. "Sabbath," verse 25. First occurrence of the noun form.
    - 2. "Six days you shall gather it, but on the seventh day. . ." Phrasing is idiomatic for Sabbath laws.
      - a. Ex. 20:9-11; 23:12; 31:15,17; 34:21; 35:2
    - 3. "Some people went out to gather," verse 27.
    - 1. Problems over obedience Ezekiel 20:10-13.
  - E. Verse 28.
    - 1. Refused to keep the command.

- F. Verses 29-30.
  - 1. "The Lord (Yahweh) has given you the Sabbath," verse 25.
  - 2. A divine gift. Jesus' view Mark 2:27.
  - 3. "Rest on the seventh day," or people kept the Sabbath.
  - 4. Typical practice evening until evening.
  - 5. God's blessing Isaiah 58:13-14.
- G. Verses 31-32.
  - 1. Manna as coriander seed, verse 31.
    - a. Another description Numbers 11:7-9.
  - 2. An omer, verse 32. Apparently a half gallon.
- H. Verses 33-36.
  - 1. Jar, verse 33 Aramaic for basket.
  - 2. "Throughout your generations," verse 33.
    - a. Reminder, but forgotten.
  - 3. Placed before the testimony, verse 34.
    - a. Exodus 38:21, Numbers 1:50,53.
  - 4. Forty years, verse 35.
    - a. Joshua 5:12.
- III. Application and Reflection.
  - A. Sabbath Regulation is highly significant.
    - 1. Significance in the Law, but also creation Gen. 2:2-3.
    - 2. Unique in the ancient world.
    - 3. Be careful of easily dismissing Sabbath regulations.
    - 4. Reasons for viewing it as fulfilled.
    - 5. Reasons for observing it in some way.
      - a. Westminster Confession of Faith.
      - b. Heidleburg Catechism.
      - c. Early church special day
