"The First Pilgrims and Their Feasts" – Exodus 23:14-19

- I. Introduction.
  - A. Pilgrims
    - 1. Those Pilgrims from Europe.
    - 2. Modern Day Other Religions.
  - B. Pilgrim is found in today's text.
    - 1. Exodus 23:16
      - a. "Times" equates to "foot." Travel required.
  - C. Today's text: Exodus 23:14-19
- II. Exposition
  - A. Feast of Unleavened Bread
    - 1. Exodus 23:15a
      - a. Additional information on this festival Ex. 12:43-13:10
      - b. Note the connection of Passover to the Feast of Unleavened Bread.
      - c. Mercy of the two Salvation from Egypt.
  - B. Exodus 12:16a Feast of Harvest.
    - 1. Also known as the Feast of First Fruits.
      - a. Leviticus 23:9-11
      - b. Lasted fifty days.
  - C. Exodus 23:16b Feast of Ingathering
    - 1. Lasted a full week.
    - 2. Also called Feast of B\_\_\_\_\_ or Feast of T\_\_\_\_\_.
      a. Leviticus 23:41-43
    - 3. Exodus reenacted.
    - 4. People are to bring their T\_\_\_\_\_ -- Ex. 23:15b; Dt. 16:17
- III. Grace Remembered
  - A. Forgetful people need reminders.
    - 1. Unleavened bread, harvest, and ingathering.

- 2. Correlates to the Gospel.
  - a. Unleavened bread linkage to Passover.
    - 1. The sweeping of the house.
    - 2. We, too, leave the old behind.
      - a. I Corinthians 5:7-8
- 2. Feast of Harvest
  - a. Signals the Resurrection.
    - 1. I Cor. 15:20; I Cor. 15:22-23
  - b. Also signals the Final Judgment.
  - c. Note term for the feast was P\_\_\_\_\_
    - 1. Mark 13:24-30
- 3. Feast of Ingathering
  - a. Known by the time of the New Testament as "The Feast"
    - 1. Climaxed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day.
    - 2. Drawing of water from the Pool of Siloam.
    - 3. Connection to Jesus John 7:38
  - b. The most animals sacrificed.
    - 1. Tremper Longman
    - 2. Hebrews 9:26b
- IV. Final Regulations
  - A. Exodus 23:17-19
    - 1. Verse 19 Garbled irrelevance or very important.

Repeated in Ex. 34:26; Deut. 14:21

- a. Two thoughts: Ryken, Currid
- 2. Men presented themselves.
  - a. Also women and children included, Deut. 16:11
