"The Golden Lampstand" – Exodus 25:31-40

- I. Introduction
 - A. Pastor Don's camping experience.
 - 1. Learning about "serious dark."
 - B. Consider the tabernacle.
 - 1. Note extensive coverings over the tent portion of the tabernacle.
 - 2. It was very dark.
 - C. Reading the Text: Exodus 25:31-40
- II. Exposition
 - A. Verses 31-36
 - 1. The lampstand would be hard to duplicate.
 - a. Menorah Hebrew means "to f______
 - 2. Note rendition found in the Arch of Titus, Rome.
 - 3. Seven lamps for sure.
 - 4. A single piece of hand-beaten gold.

weight – about 75 pounds

height – about five feet tall

- B. Verses 37-40
 - 1. Decorated with buds, blossoms, and fruit.
 - 2. One cup (saucer) was at the end of each branch and contained oil and a wick.
 - a. More detail Numbers 8:1-4
- III. Specific meanings.
 - A. Life note that the shape of the lampstand is that of a tree.
 - 1. A botanical motif of budding, blossoming, and ripening fruit symbolized God's life-giving power.
 - 2. Correlates to the Tree of Life in Genesis 2.
 - B. <u>Light</u> God is the light-giver as well as the life-giver.
 - 1. Psalm 36:9
 - 2. The lampstand was the sole light in the tent.
 - 3. The welcome sign someone was home.

- 4. God is light I John 1:5; Psalm 27:1.
- 5. Also connects to the creation account.
 - a. Genesis 1:14
- 6. The number seven completion or perfection.
- IV. Fulfillment in Christ.
 - A. Life and light
 - 1. John's gospel introduction John 1:14
 - a. We now look to Christ for life and light.
 - b. "Light and Life to all He brings"
 - Hark the Herald Angels Sing.
 - B. He is life
 - 1. Eternal life John 3:15
 - 2. Son gives life John 5:21b
 - 3. Have eternal life John 6:40
 - 4. He came to give life John 10:10
 - 5. I give eternal life John 10:28
 - 6. The resurrection and the life John 11:25
 - 7. This is eternal life John 17:3
 - C. He is light
 - 1. Promised in the Old Testament
 - a. Isaiah 9:2; 49:6b
 - 2. Fulfilled in Christ
 - a. John 1:9; 9:5b
 - D. Consider the <u>converse</u> of light and life being found in Christ alone.
 - 1. Eph. 2:1; Rom. 6:23; John 5:11-12
 - 2. Outside of Christ is death and darkness
 - a. John 3:19; 1:5; Prov. 4:19; Rom. 1:21
 - 3. Darkness leads to a life of stumbling
 - a. Eph. 4:18; John 8:12; I Peter 2:9; Eph. 5:8; II Cor. 4:6
- V. Points for Reflection.
 - A. Life and Light were symbolized in the golden lampstand and now are embodied in Jesus Christ.
 - B. Having not reached the end, we are called upon to be the light of Christ in the world.
 - C. The golden lampstand also served as a type of the church.
 - D. May we be a glorifying testimony of His saving grace.
