 - 1. Care was taken to insure the breatpiece remained in place.
 - 2. Also the 12 gemstones, representing the 12 tribes, always remained close to the priest's heart.
 - a. "Memorial," verse 29.
 - b. Note repetition of "over his heart," verses 29, 30.
 - c. The heart is the seat of love and affection.
 - d. See Hebrews 7:25, 4:15a
