 - 2. "See Thou dost say..." NASU, KJV, ESV as contrast to many other translations including the NIV.a. "Now see here, God," (Pretty direct!)
 - 3. Previously God noted that His angel would go with the people Ex. 33:2.
 - 4. Verse 13a Moses wanted God himself.
 - 5. Verse 12 indicates that God knew Moses by name. a. Said of us, too. Ps. 139:13-16; Jer. 31:3a.
 - 6. "Teach me thy <u>ways</u>."
 - a. Course directions or to know God according to His character.

 - 1. Literally, "My face will go."

- 2. Note God's response is for Moses alone.

1. Moses wants God's presence to go with all the people.

 a. True of us in Christ, too. Matt. 3:17; 17:5.

 - 1. What a request!!
 - a. Moses had caught glimpses of God's glory in the past. Exodus 3:2-6; 24:15-18; 33:9
 - b. He wanted more.

 - 1. The "yes" and "no" answer.
 - a. Partial revelation. Even angels do not see what Moses requested Isaiah 6:1-3.
