

## The Doctrines of Grace and their Application to Life "Perseverance" – Part B

- I. Review.
  - A. Last week's message.
    - 1. Philippians 1:6
  - B. Common Misconceptions
    - 1. Perseverance does not mean Christians are exempted from all spiritual danger just because they are Christians.
    - 2. Perseverance does not mean Christians are always kept from falling into sin, just because they are Christians.
    - 3. Perseverance does not mean that those who merely profess Christ without actually being born again are secure.
  - C. Christians fall but they do get up.

  - B. It beckons us to have confidence after we have experienced the pain of being fallen.
