There Is No Reason to Turn Back! An Exposition of the Book of Hebrews

#02 – "Christ Superior to Prophets" – Hebrews 1:1-3

I. Introduction

- A. A higher form of Greek is used in the outset of this letter.
 - 1. It requires more preaching time.
- B. Today's text: Hebrews 1:1-3

II. Exposition

- A. "In many portions and in many ways"
 - 1. NASU does a better job of translating POLUTROPOS.
 - a. Think of portions of a sliced pie Eph. 3:4-6
 - b. In the past, the progressive revelation was only in slices and portions but now the full revelation is in the Son.
 - 2. The prophets were <u>friends</u> of <u>God</u> while Jesus is the Son of God.
- B. "In these last days," verse 2.
 - 1. A shift in the revelation of God. He spoke in a former way. Now He spoke differently.
 - 2. Revelation terminates in the Son Gal. 1:8-9, 11
- C. "Has spoken to us in His Son," verse 2.
 - 1. Note the pronoun "His" is not in the original which is very odd. Also note that the definite article "the" is also absent.
 - 2. This is written to accentuate that all revelation ends in the Son. He is the language of God. John 1:1
- D. The purpose of the Hebrews letter.

- 1. It is found in the opening remarks "in Son" God's final and complete revelation.
- 2. Verses 1-3 become a thesis statement for the letter.
- 3. The emphasis moves from all revelation being found in the Son to what the Son has achieved.
 - a. Heb. 7:22; 8;6; 8:7-8; 10:9
- 4. On the exclusivity of Christ
 - a. Matt. 7:13-14; John 14:6; 3:34-36
- 5. Jesus fulfilled the Law both <u>actively</u> and <u>passively</u>.
- 6. Jews slowly heard throughout the Roman Empire what Jesus achieved on the cross. They were dispersed throughout the Mediterranean and most lost the ability to read Hebrew. A Greek translation of the Old Testament was commissioned to be done for these dispersed Jews.
 - a. The Septuagint (LXX)
- 7. Importance of the temple Jewish Christians were worshipping in connection to the temple.
 - a. Acts 2:46; 3:11; 4:1

III. Points for Reflection

- A. Christ is the radiance of the Father, verse 3.
 - 1. John 14:6-11
- B. Jesus is the exact representation of His nature, verse 3
- C. Jesus upholds all things by the Word of His power, verse 3.
 - 1. John 1:1; Col. 1:7
- D. Jesus made purification for sins, verse 3.
 - 1. Isaiah 43:25; Lev. 16:30; I John 1:7; Acts 20:28
- E. Jesus sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, verse 3.
 - 1. Heb. 10:1,3
