Hebrews 3:12-19

"12 Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God. 13 But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called 'Today,' so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. 14 For we have become partakers of Christ, if we hold fast the beginning of our assurance firm until the end.

'15 while it is said, 'TODAY IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS, AS WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME.' 16 For who provoked Him when they had heard? Indeed, did not all those who came out of Egypt led by Moses? 17 And with whom was He angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who were disobedient? 19 So we see that they were not able to enter because of unbelief."

Hebrews 3:12

Hebrews 6:6

"6 ...and then have fallen away, it is impossible to renew them again to repentance, since they again crucify to themselves the Son of God and put Him to open shame."

Hebrews 3:13

John 14:16

"16 I will ask the Father, and He will give you another <u>Helper</u>, that He may be with you forever."

Hebrews 3:14

First A good beginning does not ensure a good ending.

Hebrews 3:15

"15 while it is said, 'TODAY IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS, AS WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME."

Second How dreadful it is to become hard-hearted toward God.

Hebrews 3:17-18

"17 And with whom was He angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who were disobedient?"

<u>Third</u> Note the reality of God's wrath against sin.

Hebrews 3:19

"19 So we see that they were not able to enter because of unbelief."

Lack of evidence is not the cause of unbelief.

Westminster Shorter Catechism #14

Q: What is sin?

A: Sin is disobeying or not conforming to God's law in any way.

If the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23), then were all of the Israelites who died in the wilderness also consigned to Hell?
