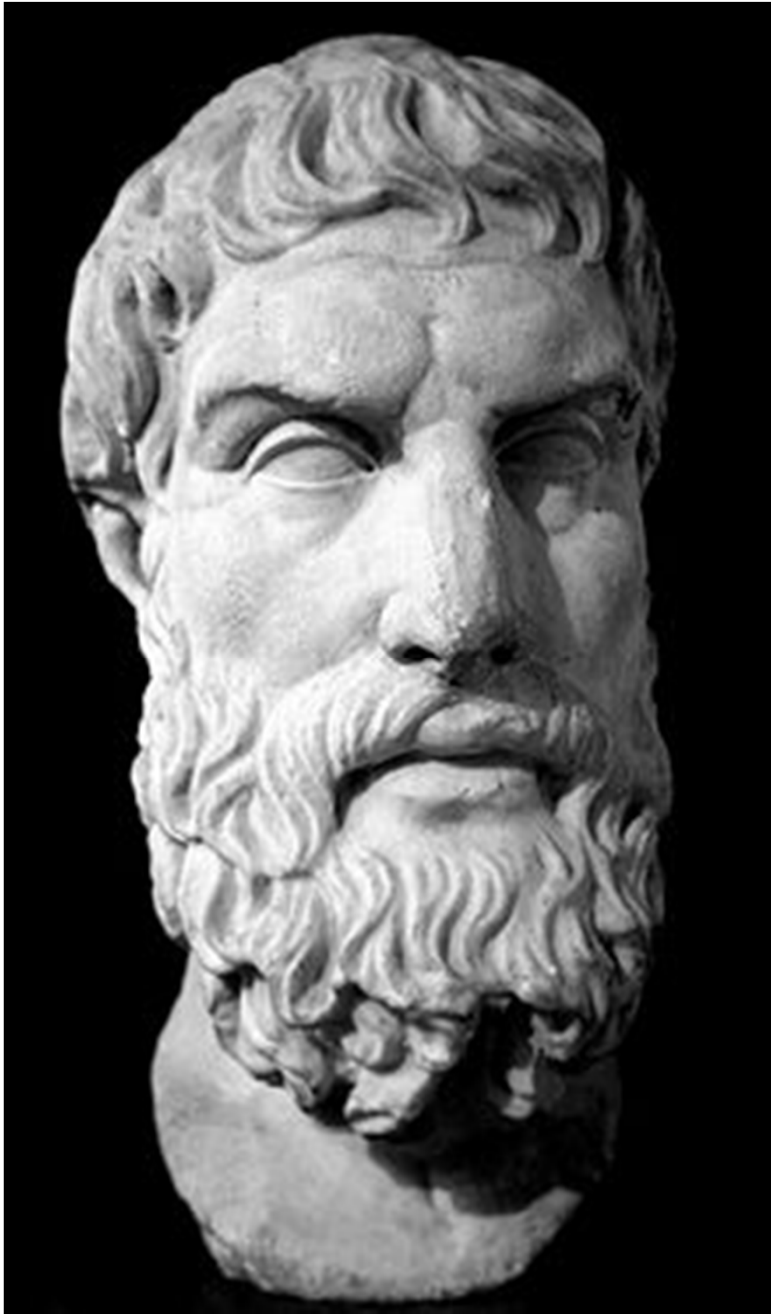

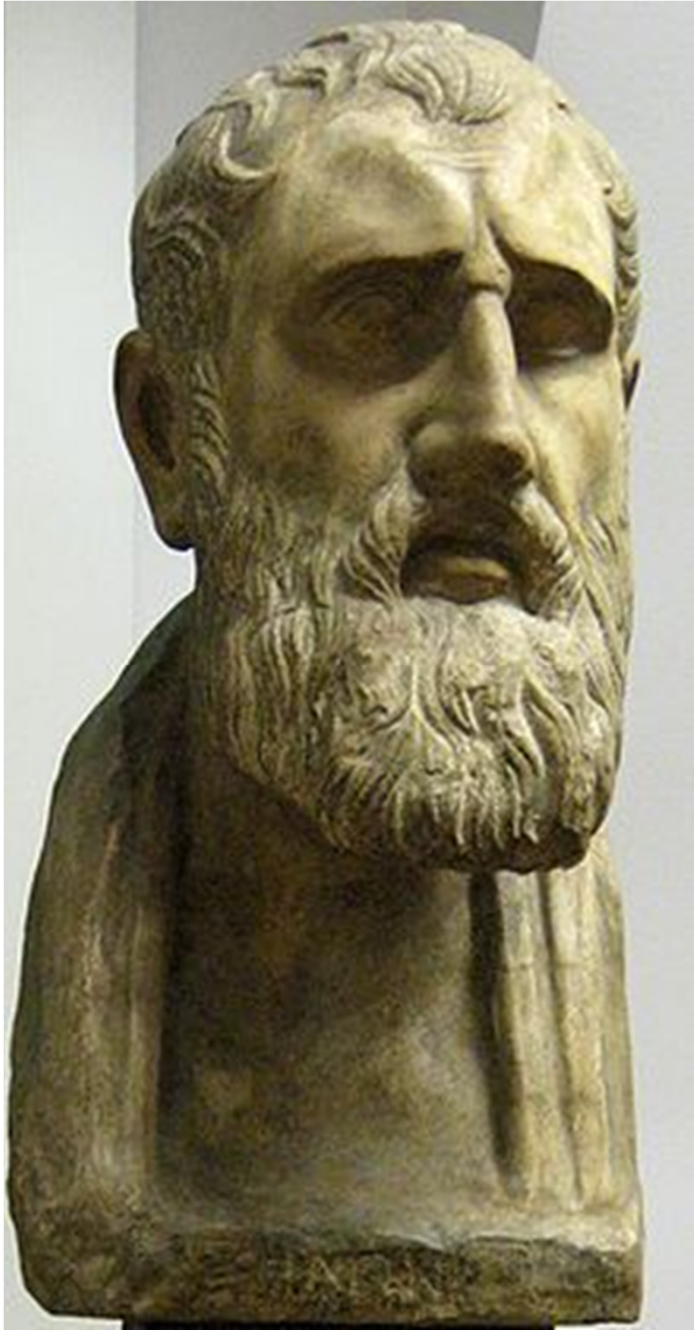

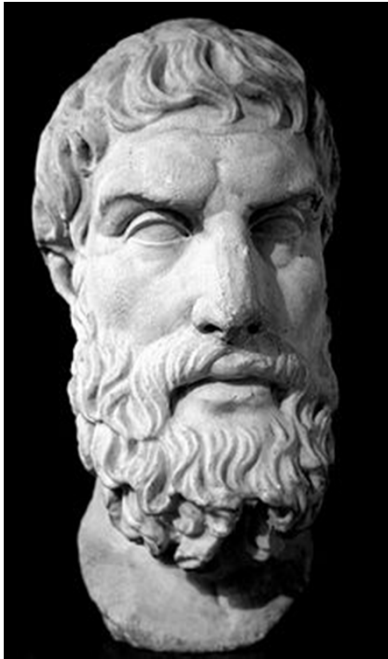
The key to life is pleasure.

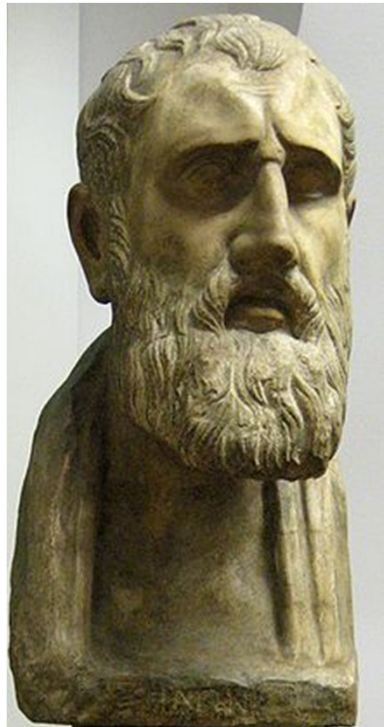
