#8: One on One – The Title Match Begins Luke 4:1-13

Malachi 3:1

"¹ 'Behold, I am going to send My messenger, and he will clear the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming,' says the Lord of hosts."

Malachi 4:1

"¹ 'For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze,' says the Lord of hosts, 'so that it will leave them neither root nor branch.""

"If" is better translated as "since".

"³⁰ I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me."

John 6:38

"³⁸ For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me."

Deuteronomy 8:3

"³ He humbled you and let you be hungry, and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that <u>man does not live by</u> <u>bread alone</u>, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord."

John 4:34

"³⁴ Jesus said to them, '<u>My food is to do the</u> will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work.""

⁴⁴⁹ And he led Him to Jerusalem and had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, 'If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here; ¹⁰ for it is written, "HE WILL COMMAND HIS ANGELS CONCERNING YOU TO GUARD YOU," ¹¹ and, "ON their HANDS THEY WILL BEAR YOU UP, SO THAT YOU WILL NOT STRIKE YOUR FOOT AGAINST A STONE."¹² And Jesus answered and said to him, 'It is said, "YOU SHALL NOT PUT THE LORD YOUR GOD TO THE TEST.""
