#101 – "Courage At the Foot of the Cross" – Luke 23:50-56

- I. Introduction
 - A. Noting the Renaissance artist of Gerard David.
 - 1. "The Deposition"
 - 2. A key part seems out of place, but on closer examination reveals the artist's purpose.
 - B. The Text: Luke 23:50-56
- II. Exposition
 - A. Luke 23:50-56
 - 1. Jesus' death confirmed.
 - a. I Cor. 15:3-4; John 19:31-33; Mark 15:44-45
 - 2. Three great doctrines
 - a. The death was confirmation of His incarnation.
 - 1. Jesus was wholly God and wholly man.
 - 2. He had to be alive in order to die.
 - b. Jesus is the payment for our atonement.
 - 1. Origin of death Gen. 2:17
 - 2. Regarding justice Romans 6:23
 - 3. Jesus died in our place Ps. 22:15; Isa. 53:8-9; Romans 5:10; Heb. 2:14-15; 1 Thess. 4:14
 - c. <u>The death of Christ was a necessary work for the</u> resurrection to take place.
 - 1. There can be no Easter without Good Friday.
 - 3. Notice that Jesus was buried alone.

a. Luke 23:53

- b. Pastor Don's study while in Israel.
- 4. Note verse 55 There would be no mistaken identity.

- B. Special followers
 - 1. Joseph of Arimathea
 - a. A closet follower John 19:38
 - b. Member of the Sanhedrin
 - c. Good and righteous man, looking for the kingdom of God Verses 50-51.
 - d. He desired no further desecration of Jesus' body, vs 52.
 - e. Not an everyday request "Took courage" Mk 15:43.
 - f. Wealthy individual with social status, consequently he had much to lose.
 - g. A costly act of compassion
 - fine linen hand-cut tomb Matt. 27:60.
 - h. A career killer, verse 51.
 - i. Confirmation of Isaiah 53:9
 - 2. Nicodemus
 - a. He was present, too John 19:39
 - b. He brought spices
 - c. The two men together brought Jesus down John 19:40.
 - 3. There were others, too. Devoted women Luke 23:54-56.
 - a. Supporters of Jesus' ministry Mk 15:40-46; Lk 8:1-3.
 - b. They stayed at the cross through the bitter end.

III. Points for Reflection.

- A. Those women present at the cross set aside their own compassionate desires for Jesus in order to obey the command of God.
- B. Without the help of women, men will never become the leaders God has called them to be.
- C. We all need courage to make a stand.
