## A. Luke 24:44

- 1. An old professor's admonishment on preaching.
- 2. Jesus preaching the Law, Prophets, Psalms
  - a. "Spoke to you" Already covered in the past.
- 3. Law of Moses, Prophets, Psalms common description of the Old Testament.
- 4. Entire Bible is about Jesus a. Some examples
- B. Luke 24:45-46
  - 1. One of Pastor Don's favorite Bible passages.
  - 2. The Scriptures were not understood in the past.

a. Luke 9:44; 18:34

- 3. Jesus opened their minds.
- C. Luke 24:47
  - 1. Jesus is ending his ministry the same way He began with the call for repentance Matthew 4:17
  - 2. Notice the emphasis upon repentance.
    - a. Luke 1:77; 3:3; 5:20; 7:48; 11:4; 23:34a
  - 3. The disciples did the same.
    - a. Acts 2:38; 5:30-31; 10:43; 13:38
  - 4. Forgiveness only takes place after an acknowledgment of transgression.
  - 5. "Proclaimed in His name to all the nations."
    - a. The missionary call
    - b. This was always the plan.
      - 1. Gen. 12:2-3; Gal. 3:16, 19
      - 2. Isaiah 49:6; Psalm 22:27
- III. Points for Reflection
  - A. The opening of the mind is indispensable to understanding the gospel.
    - 1. Luke 24:45; I Cor. 2:14; Rom. 3:10-18; Titus 3:5; John 3:19; I Peter 1:3
  - B. Repentance is a necessary aspect of Salvation that must be preached when the gospel is heralded.
    - 1. Matt. 4:17; Luke 24:47
  - C. Forgiveness of sins was proclaimed and should continue to be proclaimed.
    - 1. Luke 1:77; 3:3; 5:20; 11:4
