

Luke 8:1,4

"¹ Soon afterwards, He began going around from one city and village to another, proclaiming and preaching the kingdom of God. The twelve were with Him. ... ⁴ When a large crowd was coming together, and those from the various cities were journeying to Him, He spoke by way of a parable."



Luke 8:5-8

⁴⁵ 'The sower went out to sow his seed; and as he sowed, some fell beside the road, and it was trampled under foot and the birds of the air ate it up. ⁶ Other seed fell on rocky soil, and as soon as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture. ⁷ Other seed fell among the thorns; and the thorns grew up with it and choked it out. ⁸ Other seed fell into the good soil, and grew up, and produced a crop a hundred times as great.' As He said these things, He would call out, 'He who has ears to hear, let him hear.'''

Parables remind us that it still takes the Holy Spirit to provide complete understanding.

Deuteronomy 30:6

"⁶ Moreover the Lord your God will <u>circumcise your heart</u> and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, <u>so that you may live</u>."

Ezekiel 36:26-27

^{*26} Moreover, I will <u>give you a new</u> <u>heart</u> and put a new spirit within you; and I will <u>remove the heart</u> of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ <u>I will put My Spirit</u> within you and <u>cause you to walk</u> in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances."

<u>Titus 3:5</u>

^{**5} He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, <u>but according to His</u> <u>mercy</u>, by the <u>washing of</u> <u>regeneration</u> and renewing by the Holy Spirit."
