#31 – "The Question of the Ages" – Luke 9:18-22

- I. Introduction
 - A. Difficult questions facing people in the early 21st century.
 - 1. Examples.
 - B. Yet, there is one supreme question standing head and shoulders above all others.
 - 1. Who is J_____ C____.
 - 2. The disciples faced this question.
 - a. Note their on-the-job training thus far.
 - b. They still had to be wondering who is this g_____.
 - 3. Herod had asked the question earlier Luke 9:9.
 - C. Today's Text.
 - 1. A point blank question to the disciples.
 - a. Luke 9:18-22
 - 2. The answer did not come from human reasoning.

II. Exposition

- A. Luke 9:18-19
 - 1. With the occurrence of the question, Luke skips over seven other important events. See Mark 6:45-8:26.
 - 2. The Galilean ministry is now at an end.
 - 3. Note that the question is precipitated with prayer.
 - 4. The question What is "the word on the street?"
 - 5. Various answers and the reasons for them.
 - a. John the Baptist
 - b. Elijah
 - c. Prophet

B. Luke 9: 20

- 1. The narrowing of focus
- 2. Correct answer The Christ of God
 - a. Title of honor
 - b. The anointed one.
 - 1. Anointing for priests & prophets: Ex. 29:7; Isa. 61:1
 - 2. Anointing for kings: I Sam. 16; I Kgs 1:39; II Kgs 9
- 3. There were indications in the Old Testament that a special anointed one would come. (See Gen. 3:15; Deut. 18:18; Micah 5:2; Isa. 9:7; II Sam 7:12-16; Ps. 89:4
- 4. However, the first century Jews expected an earthly kingdom. The disciples did, too. Acts 1:6
- 5. Luke has slowly reveled Jesus' identity. Luke 1:22; 2:4; 1:32-33; 1:68ff; 2:11; 3:21-22; Acts 10:38.
- 6. "Of God" His origins.
- C. Luke 9:21-22
 - 1. Imagine the disciples' confusion.
 - 2. "Rejected"
 - 3. "Son of Man" Daniel 7:13-14

III. Points for Reflection

- A. Jesus described the <u>precise opposite</u> of their <u>expectations</u>.
- B. Jesus is far more than a prophet.
- C. Jesus is far more than a moral teacher.
- D. Jesus described who He was and then what he must do.
- E. Puzzlement or ambivalence over the identity of Jesus may still be among us.
- F. The true answer to the question is only answered correctly through the agency of the Holy Spirit.
