  - A. First: We say that we believe in God, but do we trust Him to do what only He can do?
    - 1. Concerns between <u>Presumption</u> and <u>Faith</u>.
    - 2. We need to trust God for all things.
  - B. Second: We commit a second mistake when we take our eyes off of Christ.
    - 1. The cross must be central.
      - a. I Corinthians 2:2; Galatians 6:14
  - C. Third: We also make a mistake when we seek greatness for ourselves rather than God.
    - 1. There is no place for one-upmanship.
    - 2. Everything we have is a gift.
  - D. Fourth: We make a mistake when we fight the wrong enemy.
    - 1. Be careful of judging other Christians because their practice in contending with the powers of the age are different from ours.
    - 2. We end up slaughtering other Christians in our zeal.
