<u>Luke 9:51</u> "⁵¹ And it came about, when the days were approaching for His **ascension**, that He **resolutely set His face to go to Jerusalem**."


"He set His face to go to Jerusalem," ESV.

"He stiffened his face to go to Jerusalem."

Luke 9:52-53

^{"52} And He sent messengers on ahead of Him, and they went and entered a <u>village of the Samaritans</u> to make arrangements for Him. ⁵³ But <u>they did</u> <u>not receive Him</u>, because He was traveling toward Jerusalem."





Luke 9:55-56

⁽⁵⁵ But He turned and rebuked them, [and said, 'You do not know what kind of spirit you are of; ⁵⁶ for the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them.'] And they went on to another village."

Luke 9:57

"⁵⁷ As they were going along the road, someone said to Him, 'I will follow You wherever You go."

"⁵⁸ And Jesus said to him, 'The foxes have holes and the birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head.""

^{••61} Another also said, 'I will follow You, Lord; but first permit me to say good-bye to those at home.' ⁶² But Jesus said to him, 'No one, after putting his hand to the plow and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.'''

I Kings 19:19-21

^{••19} So he departed from there and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, while he was plowing with twelve pairs of oxen before him, and he with the twelfth. And Elijah passed over to him and threw his mantle on him. ²⁰ He left the oxen and ran after Elijah and said, 'Please let me kiss my father and my mother, then I will follow you.' And he said to him, 'Go back again, for what have I done to you?' ²¹ So he returned from following him, and took the pair of oxen and sacrificed them and boiled their flesh with the implements of the oxen, and gave it to the people and they ate. Then he arose and followed Elijah and ministered to him.''
