## Luke 11:45

"45 One of the lawyers said to Him in reply, 'Teacher, when You say this, You insult us too.'"

## Luke 11:47-48

${ }^{" 47}$ Woe to you! For you build the tombs of the prophets, and it was your fathers who killed them. ${ }^{48}$ So you are witnesses and approve the deeds of your fathers; because it was they who killed them, and you build their tombs."

## Luke 11:49-51

${ }^{* 9}$ For this reason also the wisdom of God said, 'I will send to them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and some they will persecute, ${ }^{50}$ so that the blood of all the prophets, shed since the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation, ${ }^{51}$ from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, who was killed between the altar and the house of God; yes, I tell you, it shall be charged against this generation.""

## Luke 11:52

"52 Woe to you lawyers! For you have taken away the key of knowledge; you yourselves did not enter, and you hindered those who were entering."

## Luke 11:53-54

" 53 When He left there, the scribes and the Pharisees began to be very hostile and to question Him closely on many subjects, ${ }^{54}$ plotting against Him to catch Him in something He might say."

Those who hold any office of leadership within Christ's church, and who hinder the people from entering, will experience a condemnation too great for words.
