- I. Introduction
 - A. Prophet's warnings are seldom heeded.
 - 1. Israel
 - 2. Modern day example
 - B. Today's Text Luke 12:49-59
- II. Exposition
 - A. Luke 12:49-50
 - 1. Note meaning of the term "fire," vs. 49.
 - a. Most often identified with divine judgment.
 - 1. Deut. 32:22; Isa. 26:11; Jer. 4:4; Amos 1:4,7
 - b. Judgment was coming The Jews always thought it would be upon the Gentiles.
 - 1. Heb. 12:29
 - 2. "How I wish it were already kindled."
 - a. A reference to His baptism by fire, vs. 50.
 - 1. God's justice poured out.
 - 3. "Distressed" until ordeal is complete.
 - a. In Luke 9:51 Jesus' ministry pivots and He heads to Jerusalem. By the end of Chapter 12, His pace quickens.
 - B. Luke 12:51-53
 - 1. The division is over the gospel and it always divides.

- b. All Christians experience this division.
- c. Most difficult in families.
 - 1. William Barclay
- d. Also leaving non-believing friends behind
- C. Luke 12:54-56
 - 1. Weather forecasting.
 - 2. Jesus' instruction
 - a. Know the signs
 - b. Weather and hypocrisy
 - 1. Living in denial of God's storm of judgment on the rise while the miracles and teaching of Jesus are in clear view.
 - 2. Key texts: I Chr.12:32; Luke 4:21; 11:20; John 10:23
 - 3. Hypocrisy pretending to not see the obvious.
- D. Luke 12:57-59
 - 1. Better to settle before arriving at court if you are guilty.
- III. Points for Reflection
 - A. Jesus remains as the only way.
 - B. The Prince of Peace remains as the Peacemaker between God and man.
 - C. Jesus ran to His death.
 - D. Discerning the times also means never forgetting where we came from or who we really are.
