<u>Luke 20:27</u> "²⁷ Now there came to Him

some of the Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection)."

Luke 20:28-33

^{**28} And they questioned Him, saying, 'Teacher, Moses wrote for us that IF A MAN'S BROTHER DIES, having a wife, AND HE IS CHILDLESS, HIS BROTHER SHOULD MARRY THE WIFE AND RAISE UP CHILDREN TO HIS BROTHER. ²⁹ Now there were seven brothers; and the first took a wife and died childless; ³⁰ and the second ³¹ and the third married her; and in the same way all seven died, leaving no children. ³² Finally the woman died also. ³³ In the resurrection therefore, which one's wife will she be? For all seven had married her.'''

Pharisees	Sadducees
often bi-vocational	aristocratic
poor	wealthy
primarily found in synagogues throughout Palestine	located in Jerusalem
Were closer to the everyday people	Controlled the Sanhedrin – The high priest was also a Sadducee
Held to oral tradition in addition to the Scripture	Rejected oral tradition. Scripture only authoritative – The first five books alone.

Held to some figurative	Literal interpretation
language in Scripture	
Predestination	Limited the sovereignty of God
Creating binding laws	Rejected all the Pharisees' laws
Believed in the resurrection	Life after death rejected
