"The Seal of the Holy Spirit" Ephesians 1:11-14

Ephesians 1:11-12

"11 Also we have obtained an <u>inheritance</u>, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, ¹² to the end that we who were the first to hope in Christ should be to the praise of His glory."

Genesis 12:1-3

"1 Now the LORD said to Abram, 'Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father's house, to the land which I will show you; ² And I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and so you shall be a blessing; ³ and I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

John 12:32

"³² And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself."

Ephesians 1:13

"¹³ In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise." This is assent - it is necessary to salvation, but <u>not</u> sufficient for salvation. The next phrase makes this point.

"1 After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth, so that no wind should blow on the earth or on the sea or on any tree. ² And I saw another angel ascending from the rising of the sun, having the seal of the living God; and he cried out with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, ³ saying, "Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the bondservants of our God on their foreheads."
