I Peter – Encouraging Words to Exiled Christians

Comfort from the Knowledge of God's Election Lesson #1

<u>I Peter 5:13</u>

"¹³ She who is in Babylon, chosen together with you, sends you greetings, and {so does} my son, Mark."

Stand fast – I Peter 5:12

"¹² Through Silvanus, our faithful brother (for so I regard {him}, I have written to you briefly, <u>exhorting</u> and <u>testifying</u> that this is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it!"

<u>I Peter 1:1-2</u>

"¹ Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who reside as aliens, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are chosen ² according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, that you may obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood: may grace and peace be yours in fullest measure."

They are "chosen" according to God's foreknowledge.



<u>Amos 3:2</u>

"You only have I <u>chosen</u> among all the families of the earth; therefore, I will punish you for all your iniquities."

Jeremiah 1:5

"Before I formed you in the womb I <u>knew</u> you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I have appointed you a prophet to the nations."

Genesis 4:1

"¹ And Adam <u>knew</u> Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, 'I have gotten a man from the Lord."" KJV

Know is translated as "had relations" in the NASU.

Genesis 18:19

"For I <u>know</u> him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord, to do justice and judgment, that the Lord may bring upon Abraham that which He hath spoken of him."

Psalm 1:6

"For the Lord <u>knows</u> the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish."

Exodus 2:25

"And God <u>looked upon (knew</u>) the children of Israel, and God had respect unto them."

Matthew 7:22-23

"²² Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast our demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' ²³ And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.""

I Corinthians 8:3

"But if anyone loves God, he is <u>known</u> by Him."

Galatians 4:9a

"⁹ But now that you have come to <u>know</u> God, or rather to be <u>known</u> by God...."

<u>I John 3:1</u>

"¹ See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and such we are. For this reason the world does not <u>know</u> us, because it did not <u>know</u> Him."

<u>Romans 11:2</u>

"God has not rejected His people whom He <u>foreknew</u>. Or do you not know what the Scripture says in the passage about Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel?"

<u>I Peter 1:2</u>

"According to the <u>foreknowledge</u> of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, that you may obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood; May grace and peace be yours in fullest measure."

<u>I Peter 1:20</u>

"For He was <u>foreknown</u> before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you."

Romans 8:29

"For whom He <u>foreknew</u>, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren;" Peter writes to beleaguered Christians who feel as pilgrims. He encourages them by reminding them of God's particular affection for them. Note that the Trinity is involved in the process of the call. Peter says, here is the best way for me to pick you up.
