#3: God's Will Matthew 6:10

Matthew 6:10

"¹⁰ Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven."

Concerning God – Duty to God First table of the Law Your name Your Kingdom Your Will

Concerning Man's need – Duty to Man Second table of the Law Give us Forgive us Deliver us

Principle 1

Prayer is God-centered. In prayer, we speak to God, our Father in heaven.

Principle 2

There is a place for self-interest in prayer. Indeed, Jesus commands his disciples to pray for their needs. But there is a Godgiven priority and pattern for those needs.

Matthew 6:10

"¹⁰ Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven."

Mark 1:14-15

"¹⁴ Now after John had been taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, ¹⁵ and saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the <u>kingdom of</u> <u>God</u> is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

Luke 4:43

"⁴³ But He said to them, 'I must preach the <u>kingdom</u> of God to the other cities also, for I was sent for this purpose."

Luke 8:1a

"^{1a} Soon afterwards, He began going around from one city and village to another, proclaiming and preaching the <u>kingdom of God</u>. ..."

Luke 13:28

"²⁸ In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see <u>Abraham</u> and <u>Isaac</u> and <u>Jacob</u> and all the <u>prophets</u> in the <u>kingdom of God</u>, but yourselves being thrown out."

Matthew 8:11-12

^{••11} I say to you that many will come from east and west, and recline at the table with <u>Abraham</u>, <u>Isaac</u> and <u>Jacob</u> in the <u>kingdom of heaven</u>; ¹² but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Luke 17:21

"²¹ Nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or, 'There it is!' For behold, the <u>kingdom of God is in your midst</u>."

Matthew 6:10 "¹⁰ Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven."

"The Now and Not Yet"

Matthew 24:27

"²⁷ For just as the lightning comes from the east and flashes even to the west, so will <u>the coming</u> of the Son of Man be." The verse could be translated as: "Let thy kingdom <u>come now</u>." "So thy kingdom come" means the <u>full revealing of God's</u> <u>sovereign rule</u> over the world.

"The Lord of Hosts is with us – the God of Jacob is our refuge"

Psalm 23:1-2

"The Lord is my shepherd

– I shall not want.

He makes me lie down in green pastures – He leads me beside still waters" Thy kingdom come – Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Revealed Will

Hidden, Secret, or Providential Will

Deuteronomy 29:29

"²⁹ The <u>secret things</u> belong to the LORD our God (*secret will*), but the things <u>revealed</u> (*revealed will*) belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law."

Isaiah 14:24

"²⁴ The Lord of hosts has sworn saying, 'Surely, just as I have intended so it has happened, and just as I have planned so it will stand."

<u>Psalm 115:3</u>

"³ But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases."

Psalm 22:28

"²⁸ For the kingdom is the Lord's and He rules over the nations."

Praying for the revealing of God's kingdom and His will be done is to cry out as David or as saints before God's altar.

Praying for God's will to be done is also a prayer for God's will to become our will.

The value of the kingdom is infinite, and we have a taste of it now.
